## Advanced Placement Program (A.P.)

The Advanced Placement Tests administered by The College Board are used by Colorado State University to award credit and advanced placement in any of several fields in which a student may have participated in high school. Any AP credit awarded may be used toward the 12 - credit minimum requirement for graduation and may be used towards general education requirements.

A minimum score of 4 is needed for credit in the Biology, Computer Science, English, Government and Politics, and Human Geography examinations.

The following table shows the scores required and specific credits granted for each AP exam.
