1913-1914	<p>The passing grade is 70 per cent. All students who fail to make a standing of 55 per cent will be considered "failed," and will be required to take such subjects over again in class. Those making a standing of more than 55 per cent and less than 70 per cent will be considered "conditioned," and will be allowed one special examination before the subject is again taught, by which they may try for a passing grade of 70. In cases of studies extending over more than one semester the student, if he has an average of 55 per cent, may be allowed to continue with his class, but must finally make a grade of 70 per cent in one special examination in each semester. If he falls below 55 per cent in average at the end of a semester, he will be dropped from the class and be required to take a lower subject.</p> <p>Any student who shall have a semester standing of 90 per cent may be exempted from examination, and in that case his class standing shall be his semester average.</p>
